Summary: *The Wild and Scenic Rivers program is dedicated to protecting nationally significant rivers and their unique biological, recreational, scenic, historical and/or cultural resources. A locally-drafted, voluntary Stewardship Plan has been developed which will help assure the protection of our unique river resources for generations to come. There is no cost to the town. 
